As the UK prepares to exit the EU, below is a quick checklist of what will be required by importers/exports wishing to trade with the EU.

| EORI Number | Documentation | Commodity Code |

| <p>Make sure you have an Economic Operator Registration & Identification number (EORI).</p> <p>This is a requirement for Customs Clearance.</p> <p>You can apply directly to HMRC and it will take around 1 week for the number to be issued.</p> <p>www.gov.uk/eori</p> | <p>You will need to supply a commercial invoice and packing list, which should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Sales value & currency.■ Cargo weight.■ Country of origin.■ INCOTERMS. <p>This information will be used to declare the correct information to HMRC.</p> | <p>You will need commodity codes for all goods, this will allow for the correct import duty to be applied when we make your declarations.</p> <p>To find out more information, go to www.gov.uk/trade-tariff</p> |
